#### **PORTLAND USHERS - 2025**

#### **DUTIES OF USHERS AND ASSISTANTS**

Visitors receive their first impressions of the church from the ushers. Ushers should be on hand to assist in any way.

#### Pre Service

- 1. Arrive by 8:45 a.m. for the 9:15 a.m. service.
- 2. Turn on all sanctuary lights
- 3. Put a clean glass of fresh water for the Minister at the pulpit.
- 4. Verify that the amplifier in the Friendship Room is turned on. Let AV people know if not.
- 5. Distribute Orders of Service and greet worshippers as they arrive.
- 6. Light the two tall oil candles at the front of the Sanctuary 5-10 minutes before the service is to begin.

### **During Service**

- 7. Verify the exterior door to the Friendship Room is fully closed for the service.
- 8. Seat late comers at appropriate times during the service but not during the reading of the scriptures or during Prayers.
- 9. See that the door between the Friendship Room and the Sanctuary is closed during the service.
- 10. During the offertory hymn and prayer, one usher stands at the front with the offering plate and either gives it to the worship leader (if they receive it) or places it on the Communion Table.

#### **After Service**

- 11. Candles are to be extinguished at the end of the service. Please do not use the snuffer on oil candles.
- 12. Make a sweep of the pews, collecting Orders of Services and straightening hymn books, etc.
- 13. Turn off all lights in the Sanctuary after people have left, and all the other lights as well if you are the last one to leave.
- 14. Be near both doors as worshippers depart, and if possible, introduce visitors to the Minister. Remember to be generally helpful.
- 15. Be sure that the front door of the church (back of the Sanctuary) is closed properly and locked before you leave the Sanctuary. The door off the friendship room will be closed by others (unless you are the last to leave.)
